

Bright Futures Statement for Well Child Visits


All Peds Well Plan templates will have a checkbox next to a statement about Bright Futures guidelines.

For **Physician** providers, the box will be checked by default. The statement will read, "The overall plan of care for this patient is in conjunction with Bright Futures guidelines." This is the standard Bright Futures statement.

For **APP** providers, no default statement is selected. Their statement requires the date of the last well child visit with a *physician* provider and the name of that encounter physician. The grid is there for convenience. The default view shows only Well Child Visits with Physician Providers, but filters can be used to show all visit types and all provider types. The fields in the statement will accept free text.

STEPS:

Click on the "Well Visit" button > Select the Well Plan default for the visit.



The Visit History grid automatically filters to display Assessments by Physician providers. You may choose radio buttons to filter by WC (Well Child) visits, All visits and by Physician or All providers:
